The New Mexico Oil Conservation Division (OCD) has received Rice Operating Company's report and request to close the above-referenced site (dated June 24, 2011). The report is acceptable to the OCD. Please submit to the OCD a final plugging report for groundwater monitoring wells (MW-1, MW-2, MW-3 and MW-4) at the site within 90 days of receipt of this notice.

The above-referenced report, submitted in accordance with 19.15.30.19 NMAC [Section 19 of (Part 30; formally, Rule 19)], indicates that Rice Operating Company has met the requirements of 19.15.30.9 NMAC; therefore, the OCD approves the report and hereby notifies you that the abatement plan (AP-47) is terminated in accordance with 19.15.30.19.B NMAC.
