Reference is made to your application filed on September 8, 2011.

You have requested to simultaneously dedicate the Subject Unit to the Subject Wells.

The Subject Unit is an existing gas spacing unit in the above-identified pool. Applicable well density rules for this pool allow two wells to be completed in the unit, but require that the wells be in different quarter sections. Because the proposed well will be completed within both quarter sections of this unit, including the quarter section in which the existing well is also completed, division approval for simultaneous dedication is required.

Your application has been duly filed under the provisions of Division Rules 15.11.C [19.15.15.11.C NMAC] and 4.12.A [19.15.4.12.A NMAC].

It is our understanding you have proposed the simultaneous dedication of this unit to the Subject Wells for geological reasons, in order to prevent waste and maximize production from this unit. We further understand that all affected persons in offsetting units or projected units within the same pool or formation have been duly notified of this application.

Pursuant to the authority granted by Rule 15.11.C, the above-described simultaneous dedication is hereby approved.
