Gentlemen,

I have received your spill report. It looks in good order. In future, please be sure to include the lease number and/or well API number on the form. Typically, I can look this up if there is enough information elsewhere on the form, but sometimes those numbers are necessary for finding the specific site in question in the relevant databases.

As I informed Mr. Hernandez on the phone, I am having some difficulty locating this facility in the federal database. Do not know if OCD will have the same issue or not. Some of that confusion may be related to the fact that the section line between sections 23 and 22 runs through the middle of this facility. I have reported the issue to our database folks.

The federal tracking number for this event: 11NU116TG  
The name of this event: Skelly Unit Water Injection Plant

The spill location has been cleared for preliminary cleanup operations by BLM archeologists. No archeological survey or monitoring is required.

It is suggested that surface contaminants be picked up as soon as possible, preferably prior to any rainfall events. After that, the site should be fully delineated. Notify Terry Gregston, (575) 361-2635, of the delineation date. After delineation, a cleanup plan should be submitted along with the delineation data for BLM approval prior to implementing final cleanup operations.

Attached you will find a copy of the spill map for this event.
