Describe Cause of Problem and Remedial Action Taken.*
A hole/split in a 4" by 3" swedge on back of oil tank caused the spill. The well was shut off and the two oil tanks and gun barrel have been disconnected from service.

Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.*
An approximate area of 9' X 30' (on production pad inside the unlined berm). Both oil tanks and the gun barrel will be removed from the affected area so that impacted soils can be excavated from the location. All impacted soils will be taken to a NMOCD approved disposal facility. Vertical and horizontal delineation samples will be taken and analysis ran for TPH & BTEX (chlorides for documentation). If initial analytical results for TPH & BTEX are under RRAL's (site ranking is 10) a Final Report, C-141 will be submitted to the OCD requesting closure. If the analytical results are above the RRAL a work plan will be submitted to the OCD. **Depth to Ground Water: 50-99' (75', Section 27, T18S-R26E, NMOSE), Wellhead Protection Area: No, Distance to Surface Water Body: > 1000', SITE RANKING IS 10.**
