Dear Mr. Moore:

The New Mexico Oil Conservation Division (OCD) is writing to inform the Navajo Refining Company (Navajo) that it is in violation of the Underground Injection Control (UIC) Program Annual Mechanical Integrity Test (MIT) requirement for its three injection wells.

Navajo failed to conduct the annual MIT before September 30, 2011, the end of the Federal Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) Fiscal Year 2011 (Oct. 1, 2010 – Sept. 30, 2011). The OCD had sent out an e-mail reminder to operators on June 14, 2011.

The MITs require advanced notification to the OCD in order to witness the MIT; the original MIT pressure chart with signatures and test information that reflects a "pass/fail" on the chart; and a copy of the calibration sheet (every 6 months) from the used chart recorder that is scanned into the OCD well files as confirmation that the MIT requirement has been met.

Please contact Mr. Carl Chavez of my staff at (505) 476-3490 or [Carl.J.Chavez@state.nm.us](mailto:Carl.J.Chavez@state.nm.us) to schedule MITs for your injection wells to be completed before December 31, 2011. Failure to meet this date may result in escalated enforcement actions. Thank you in advance for your cooperation in this matter
