Burlington Resources applied for and received administrative approval on the San Juan 29-7 Unit #192 unorthodox gas well location for the Blanco Pictured Cliffs formation in May, 2004 by NSL-5060. This well was staked on an existing location with the San Juan 29-7 Unit #130M, a Blanco Mesaverde/Basin Dakota well which was previously approved by NSL-2078A, to reduce surface damage, as well as use existing roads and pipelines.

Burlington Resources proposes to add the Basin Fruitland Coal formation to this non-standard location application, in which the name has been changed to the San Juan 29-7 Unit #526S. The location remains the same as the approved NSL-5060.
