

Mr. Lauck:

The Oil Conservation Division (OCD) has reviewed the *Site Characterization Report* and *Subsurface Remediation Work Plan* submitted on ConocoPhillips' behalf by Conestoga-Rovers & Associates (CRA) on November 28, 2011. OCD hereby conditionally approves both the report and the workplan. ConocoPhillips must revise the workplan by adding the information that CRA to OCD via email on December 1, 2011. The revised workplan should specify that ConocoPhillips will sample MW-4 and a nearby water supply well for nitrate, sulfate, and TDS in order to attempt to show these constituents are present at background levels at the site and should specify how frequently these additional wells will be monitored. ConocoPhillips should also specify that it plans to inject approximately 60,000 gallons of Cool-Ox solution injected under pressure with some infiltration. Please submit the revised workplan by December 8, 2011.
