I. The well is on BLM oil and gas lease NMLC-0029548A and BLM surface. The well bore is 1,120' from the closest lease line. The proposed oil well is nonstandard for the ~~Cedar Lake; Glorieta-Yeso Pool (96831)~~ ^{uncles} due to land uses (LINN well). A copy of the APD cover sheet is attached (Exhibit A).

Apache requests a nonstandard location due to land uses. There are already 3 Yeso wells, 3 Grayburg Jackson; SR-Q-G-SA wells, 1 Devon power line, 4 Central Valley power lines, well roads, and multiple pipelines in the NENW Section 18.

The 224.09 acre BLM lease comprises Lots 1 & 2, E2NW4, and W2NE4 Section 18. The well was planned to be staked at 990 FNL & 1650 FWL. However, that would cut into LINN Energy's small C. A. Russell 6 well pad (30-015-05219). Linn's well pad is 24' higher than the Coffee Federal 11 well pad (see Exhibit B). LINN's pad extends only $\approx 25'$ east of its well head.

A standard location must be at least 330' from the quarter-quarter line. The well bore is 200' from the closest quarter-quarter line (see C-102 as EXHIBIT C).

II. A C-102 form showing the well and 40 acre pro ration unit (NENW Section 18) is attached as EXHIBIT C.

The oil and gas lease boundary is marked as a solid line on the attached (EXHIBIT D) topographic map. The well bore encroaches too far (130') south. All encroachments (<330') are part of the same lease. There is one Yeso well (Apache's Coffee Federal 2 (30-015-31058) is 1,349' southeast) in the encroached quarter-quarter (SENE Section 18). The quarter-quarter is part of the same BLM lease. Five of the eight bordering or cornering quarter-quarters (dashed line squares) are part of the same state lease.

III. See Exhibit E for existing Yeso wells (circles). Apache operates all existing Yeso wells (circles on Exhibit E) in the offset quarter-quarters. Closest (417') existing Yeso well is Apache's Coffee Federal 1 (30-015-31175) at 990 FNL & 2047 FWL 18-17s-31e. Apache has Yeso wells in 5 of the 8 offset quarter-quarter-quarters. Three quarter-quarters (Lot 4, SESW, & SWSE 7-18s-31e) do not have a Yeso well. This information is current and correct.

IV. See Exhibits C, D, and E for the proposed well, proration unit, drilling windows, and all wells. Apache does not believe it is cost effective to directionally drill from an existing pad. They have a horizontal Yeso well (30-015-35056) in the same quarter-quarter. Based on their experience with that well, they do not believe it is cost effective to directionally drill to a standard location.

V. See Exhibits B and D for surface uses (3 Yeso wells, 3 Grayburg Jackson; SR-Q-G-SA wells, 1 Devon power line, 4 Central Valley power lines, well roads, and multiple pipelines) that prevent use of a standard location.

VI. Archaeology is not an issue.

VII. The well was planned to be staked at 990 FNL & 1650 FWL. However, that would eat into LINN Energy's already small pad (see Exhibit B).

VIII. Apache does not believe directional drilling to a legal bottom hole location is cost effective.

IX. I hereby certify that Apache Corporation and its partners have 100% of the Yeso working interest in the lease which comprises the proposed 40 acre spacing unit and the adjacent quarter-quarters on one or more of the two sides or the single closest corner to the proposed well toward which it encroaches and that the information is current and correct.

I hereby attest that I, on or before the date that the application was submitted to the division, sent notification to the affected persons (see EXHIBIT F) by certified mail, return receipt requested, advising them that if they have an objection it must be filed in writing within 20 days from the

date the division receives the application. These affected persons have working or royalty interests in quarter-quarters which border the 40 acre spacing unit. Said notice was sent to:
