Dear Ms. Clugston :

Reference is made to the following:

- (a) your application, submitted to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division (the Division) in Santa Fe, New Mexico on March 28, 2012; and
- (b) the Division's records pertinent to your request, including previous orders cited below.

Burlington has requested approval of a non-standard, 345.25-acre gas spacing unit, described in the caption of this letter, in the Basin Mancos Gas Pool (Pool Code 97232).

The proposed non-standard gas spacing unit will be dedicated to Burlington's Reid Well No. 22M (API No. to be assigned) to be drilled from a surface location 990 feet from the South line and 915 feet from the West line (Unit M), to a bottom hole location 710 feet from the South line and 1930 feet from the West line (Unit N) of Section 8, Township 28 North, Range 9 West, NMPM, in San Juan County, New Mexico.

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Your application has been duly filed under the provisions of Division Rules 15.11.B(2) and 4.12.A(3).

We understand that you are seeking establishment of this non-standard unit due to irregularities in the official surveys, and specifically due to the small size of Irregular Sections 7 and 8. We further understand that the proposed unit has the same horizontal boundaries as existing non-standard gas spacing and proration units established in the Blanco Mesaverde Gas Pool by Order R-8170 and in the Basin Dakota Gas Pool by Order R-1814.

It is further understood that Burlington and its affiliates own 100% of the working interests in all tracts within Sections 7 and 8 that are excluded from the proposed unit. Accordingly no notice of this application is necessary.

Pursuant to the authority conferred by Rule 15.11.B(2), the above-described non-standard 345.25-acre gas spacing unit is hereby approved.

Jurisdiction of this case is retained for the entry of such further orders as the Division may deem necessary.
