Lease Operator reported Staining around tank had oil transferred to another tank and had tank cleaned out for inspection. Suspect tank and neighboring tank were removed. It was determined there was a hole in the bottom of the tank.

**Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken \***  
An approximate size of 15' x 20' was impacted. The impacted area is located beneath the west oil tank. Soil from the impacted areas will be excavated and disposed of at an NMOCD approved facility. Vertical and horizontal delineation samples will taken and analysis ran for TPH and BTEX once all contaminated material has been removed. **Depth to Ground Water: >100' (approx. 175' per New Mexico ChevronTexaco Trend Map 2005); Wellhead Protection Area: No; Distance to Surface Water Body: >1000'; SITE RANKING IS 0.**
