Reference is made to your amended application received on June 5, 2012.

You have requested to drill or complete this horizontal well at an unorthodox oil well location described above in the referenced pool or formation. This location is governed by statewide Rule 15.9.A [19.15.15.9.A NMAC], which provides for 40-acre units, with wells located at least 330 feet from a unit outer boundary, and Rule 15.16.14.B(2) [19.15.16.14.B(2) NMAC] concerning directional wells in designated project areas. This location is unorthodox because portions of the proposed completed interval are less than 330 feet from an outer boundary of the project area.

Your application has been duly filed under the provisions of Division Rules 15.13 [19.15.15.13 NMAC] and 4.12.A(2) [19.15.4.12.A(2) NMAC].

It is our understanding that you are seeking this location for engineering reasons, in order to maximize the productive length of the wellbore lateral within the producing area.


It is also understood that this proposed location does not encroach further toward any adjoining unit that the location approved without objections in Administrative Order NSL-6576..

Pursuant to the authority conferred by Division Rule 15.13.B, the above-described unorthodox location is hereby approved.
