COG Operating, LLC is hereby authorized to surface commingle oil and gas production from the Fren; Glorieta-Yeso Pool (**26770**) from the following Federal Leases and wells.

Puckett 12 Federal Well No. 7H (**API 30-015-39476**), SE/4SE/4, Section 12, T-17-S, R-31-E.

Puckett 12 Federal Well No. 8H (**API No. Pending**), SE/4SE/4, Section 12, T-17-S, R-31-E.

Puckett 13 Federal Well No. 5H (**API No. 30-015-39657**), NW/4NE/4, Sect 13, T-17-S, R-31-E.

Puckett 13 Federal Well No. 6H (**API No. Pending**), NW/4NE/4 Section 13, T-17-S, R-31-E.

Puckett 13 Federal Well No. 7H (**API No. 30-015-39178**), NE/4NE/4, Sect 13, T-17-S, R-31-E

Puckett 13 Federal Well No. 8H (**API No. 30-015-39658**), SE/4SE/4, Sect 12, T-17-S, R-31-E

All in NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico

The commingled oil and gas production from the wells detailed above shall be measured and sold at the Central Tank Battery (CTB), located in the SW/4SW/4 of Section 12 Township 17 South, Range 31 East, NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico.

The oil and gas production from each well shall be continuously measured with allocation meters before commingling with production from other wells. The allocation meters shall be calibrated monthly.

NOTE: This installation shall be installed and operated in accordance with the applicable Division Rules and Regulations. It is the responsibility of the producer to notify the transporter of this commingling authority.


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FURTHER: The operator shall notify the Artesia District office of the Division prior to implementation of the commingling operations.

This approval is subject to like approval from the Bureau of Land Management (BLM) before commencing the commingling operations.
