Apache Corporation ("Apache") is hereby authorize to surface commingle oil and gas production from the following Pools located in Sections 12 and 13, Township 24 South, Range 36 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico.

Langlie Mattix; Seven Rivers-Queen-Grayburg (Oil) Pool (37240)

and from the following diversely owned wells located on Fee leases in Lea County, New Mexico:

The commingled production shall be measured and sold at the Central Tank Battery located in Section 13, Township 24 South, Range 36 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico. Oil and gas production from the wells is approved for off lease measurement and sales.


Oil and gas production from the wells shall be allocated on the basis of monthly periodic well tests, while total production from all the wells commingled at the Central Tank Battery shall be metered prior to being sold. This meter shall be calibrated semi-annually.

The producer/operator shall notify the transporter of this commingling authority.
