Logos Resources, LLC ("Logos") is hereby authorized to surface commingle gas production from the following Pools located in Sections 5 and 8, Township 23 North, Range 6 West, NMPM, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico.

Counselors; Gallup-Dakota Pool (13379)  
Wildcat; Mesa-Verde Pool

and from the following diversely owned wells located on Fee and Federal leases in Rio Arriba County, New Mexico:

Well Name & Number	API No.	Well Location
RITA Well No. 5	30 039-23351	Section 5, T-23-N, R-6-W
RITA COM Well No. 2	30-039-22883	Section 5, T-23-N, R-6-W

Each well has its own tank battery. Gas production from each well shall be continuously measured with allocation meters before commingling with production from other wells. The allocation meters shall be calibrated quarterly.

The purpose of this commingling is to install a single compressor that will compress gas from all three wells at once instead of installing individual compressors.


The producer/operator shall notify the transporter of this commingling authority.

The operator shall notify the Aztec district office of the Division upon commencement of commingling operations.
