Reference is made to your application received on November 11, 2012.

You have requested to drill this well at an unorthodox location described above in the referenced pool or formation. This location is governed by the Special Rules and Regulations for the Basin-Dakota Gas Pool, which provides for 320-acre units with wells located at least 660 feet from a unit outer boundary. This location is less than 660 feet from a unit outer boundary.

Your application has been duly filed under the provisions of Division Rules 15.13 [19.15.15.13 NMAC] and 4.12.A(2) [19.15.4.12.A(2) NMAC].

It is our understanding that you are seeking this location in order to minimize surface usage.

It is also understood that you have executed waivers of objection to this application from all operators or owners who are "affected persons," as defined in Rule 4.12.A(2), in all adjoining units towards which the proposed location encroaches.

Pursuant to the authority conferred by Division Rule 15.13.B, the above-described unorthodox location is hereby approved.

This approval is subject to your being in compliance with all other applicable Division rules, including, but not limited to Division Rule 5.9 [19.15.15.9 NMAC].

Jurisdiction of this case is retained for the entry of such further orders as the Division may deem necessary.
