Marathon Oil Company requests administrative approval for a non-standard gas proration unit for the J. L. Muncy Well No. 1. The legal description of this well is as follows:

~~A non-standard gas proration unit consisting of the E/2 SW 1/4 and the S/2 SE 1/4 is requested for this well.~~ Administrative approval is required for this 160 acre unit because it crosses quarter section lines. There is one other Tubb gas well located on this lease. The J. L. Muncy Well No. 6 is one location north of Well No. 1 in Unit I. This is a newly drilled well. Production from Well No. 6 is 1.4 MMCFPD, while Well No. 1 produces 111 MCFPD.



Marathon Oil Company has requested the Oil Conservation Division for administrative approval for a non-standard gas proration unit for the J. L. Muncy Well No. 1. The exact legal description for this well is as follows:

660' FEL & 660' FSL  
Unit P, Section 24, T22S, R37E  
Lea County, New Mexico

The pool rules for the Tubb Oil & Gas Pool require gas wells to be located on a tract consisting of 160 surface acres in the form of a square, which is a quarter section. The proposed acreage dedication is illustrated on the attached Form C-102. This non-standard unit is the result of a newly drilled Tubb completion located just north of Well No. 1. Production from this new well, J. L. Muncy Well No. 6, tested at a rate of 1.4 MMCFPD; Well No. 1 produces 111 MCFPD.

As stated in the Special Pool Rules for the Tubb Oil & Gas Pool, the Division Director may grant approval to this application provided no offset operator has entered an objection within 30 days after receiving the application. 
