Reference is unde to your letter dated June 15, 1965, wherein you request an amendment to Administrative Order PC-43 which as amended authorized the comingling of Ellenburger, Devonian, McKee, Fasselmen, and Drinkard production underlying your Hodges Lease, North Justic Field, Los County, New Marico, after separately metering the production from each pool.

It is our understanding that the commiscling installation is at present handling Borth Justic Passelman and North Justic Devonian production from three wells and that all of the wells are of marginal nature; you therefore wish to commingle on the basis of pariodic well tests.

Please notify the Commission in the event that any wall in either of the aferegaid pools becomes capable of top allowable production.
