Reference is made to your recent submission of a proposed allocation schedule for six Cooper Jal Unit wells authorized for downhole commingling of production by Division Order DHC-1131.

As the wells have been completed and test data acquired, allocation of production from the wells shall be on the following basis:



Cooper Jal Unit No.413	28%	42%	72%	58%
Cooper Jal Unit No.415	57%	15%	43%	85%
