Dear Mr. Stogner

This is a request for administrative approval for a non-standard gas well location in the Basin Fruitland Coal pool.

The Sammons #100S is staked at an unorthodox location due to terrain and residential issues. Residential homes encompass a majority of the area within the legal spacing window for the formation. As a result, no suitable location could be found within the window. Consequently, this locations was staked non-standard for the Fruitland Coal formation, to best fit the terrain and residential conditions. See the attached topo map for further clarification.


Production from the Fruitland Coal is included in the 320-acre gas spacing unit, the east half dedication of Section 32, T30N, R12W.

To comply with the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division rules, we are submitting the following for your approval of this non-standard location:






