Dear Ms. Bailey:

Chesapeake Operating Inc. (OGRID No. 147179) hereby seeks administrative approval pursuant to the provisions of Division Rule 19.15.15.13 NMAC for an unorthodox well location for Chevron USA, Inc.'s McCloy Ranch 2 24 32 State Com 2H well to be located in Section 2, Township 24 South, Range 32 East, N.M.P.M., Lea County, New Mexico. The proposed well is to be drilled horizontally at a surface location 100 feet from the South line and 400 feet from the West line of Section 2. The first perforations in the well will be at a point 330 feet from the South line and approximately 400 feet from the West line of the project area. The bottom-hole location will be 150 feet from the North line and 400 feet from the West line of Section 2. A 160-acre project area has been dedicated to this horizontal well comprised of the W/2 W/2 of Section 2.

Exhibit A is a land plat for Section 2 and surrounding sections that shows the proposed non-standard location of the McCloy Ranch 2 24 32 State Com 2H well in relation to adjoining units and existing wells. This location is unorthodox because this acreage is governed by the Division's statewide rules which provide for wells on 40-acre spacing units to be located no closer than 330 feet to the outer boundary of the spacing unit. The bottom-hole location of this well will be 150 feet from the North line of Section 2 for engineering reasons and is, therefore, closer to the section line than allowed by Division rules.

Exhibit B is the Well Location and Acreage Dedication Plat (Form C-102), which shows that the proposed McCloy Ranch 2 24 32 State Com 2H well encroaches on the spacing and proration unit to the North.



Exhibit C is a list of the affected parties. Pursuant to 19.15.4.12(A)(2)(c) NMAC, affected parties are those toward whom the non-standard location encroaches. Here, the proposed bottom-hole location encroaches to the North. The affected party is United States Bureau of Land Management (BLM). Notice of this application with all attachments has been sent to the BLM at the address indicated on Exhibit C.



Enclosed is a copy of the above-referenced application which was filed with the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division on November 16, 2012 by Chesapeake Operating Co. for administrative approval of an unorthodox well location for its Chevron USA, Inc.'s McCloy Ranch 2 24 32 State Com 2H well to be located in Section 2, Township 24 South, Range 32 East, N.M.P.M., Lea County, New Mexico. Greetings.

Chesapeake hereby withdraws its application for a non-standard location for the McCloy Ranch 2 24 32 St. Com 4H, filed on November 16, 2012.

As to the application for a non-standard location for the McCloy Ranch 2 24 32 St. Com 2H, you brought to our attention the fact that under the existing C-102, this well not only encroaches upon the unleased BLM property to the north, but also upon the EOG property to the northwest. After considering this fact, Chesapeake intends to file an amended C-102 indicating that its final perforations within the completed interval will be greater than 467 feet from the northwest corner, but still closer than 330 feet from the north. Therefore, the well will no longer be encroaching on EOG to the northwest, but will still be encroaching upon the unleased BLM property to the north.

As soon as I receive a filed copy of the amended C-102, I will send it to you for your review and case file records.

Based on this alteration to the application, I presume that the original notice and filing date of November 16, 2012, will function as the start of the notice/protest clock and that this application will be ripe for approval after December 6, or 20 days from the date the application was received by the Division.

Please advise me if this understanding is correct and whether, after the time has run, the BLM has objected to the application. Also, please acknowledge for my records that the Division has withdrawn the McCloy Ranch 2 24 32 St. Com 4H NSL application.

David,

Attached is Chesapeake's amended C-102 indicating that the last perforation in the completed interval will be at a location 180 feet from the north line of the section and 400 feet from the west line. EOG has agreed to waive their objections to any locations further than 438.23 from the northwest corner. I have attached EOG's waiver again to this email for reference. Chesapeake's amended to the C-102 puts the last perforation at a location 438.63 feet from the northwest corner of the section and, thus, at a distance that complies with the terms of EOG's waiver.

With this waiver and amended C-102, I believe Chesapeake has addressed the Division's concerns regarding EOG's interests to the northwest. That leaves only the BLM to the north. Has the BLM protested the unorthodox location?

If you find the foregoing satisfactory, please have the appropriate authority sign and date both copies of this letter and return one copy to the attention of the undersigned at the letterhead address.




