

Oxy began flaring at the Cypress 32 Federal #4 location at 10:00 a.m. today 6-28-12 with approximately 750 MCF's per day

Oxy also began flaring at the Goodnight 27 Federal #2 location at 11:00a.m. today 6-28-12 with approximately 2300 MCF's per day.

These flares were due to Southern Union Gas shutting in their lines for an emergency.

The appropriate paperwork will be sent in the mail following the conclusion of the flaring event.
