Dear Ms. Staley:

The Farmington District Office (FDO) of the Bureau of Land Management (BLM) has received your letter dated March 18, 1996, for downhole commingling of the Blanco Mesaverde and Basin Dakota Pools in the above referenced well.

The Dakota formation is producing 69 MCFD and .35 BCPD and the Mesaverde is producing 227 MCFD and 1.43 BCPD per January 1996 test data. Corrected bottom hole pressures are 626 psi for the Mesaverde and 685 psi for the Dakota. Using these values, the fixed percentage for allocated production for each formation has been determined as follows:

FORMATION	GAS PRODUCTION	OIL PRODUCTION
Blanco Mesaverde	77%	80%
Basin Dakota	23%	20%

Approval to downhole commingle the Blanco Mesaverde and Basin Dakota formations for the above referenced well is hereby granted.
