Reference is made to your application received on February 15, 2013.

You have requested to re-complete this well at an unorthodox gas well location described above, in the referenced pools or formations. This location is governed by the Special Rules and Regulations for the Blanco Mesaverde Gas Pool and the Special Rules and Regulations for the Basin Dakota Gas Pool, both of which provide for 320-acre units, with wells located at least 660 feet from a unit outer boundary. This location is less than 660 feet from a unit boundary of each of the proposed units.

Your application has been duly filed under the provisions of Division Rules 15.13 [19.15.15.13 NMAC] and 4.12.A(2) [19.15.4.12.A(2) NMAC].

It is our understanding that you are seeking this location for topographic reasons.

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It is also understood that notice of this application to offsetting operators or owners is unnecessary due to common ownership.

Pursuant to the authority conferred by Division Rule 15.13.B, the above-described unorthodox location is hereby approved.

This approval is subject to your being in compliance with all other applicable Division rules, including, but not limited to Division Rule 5.9 [19.15.15.9 NMAC].

Jurisdiction of this case is retained for the entry of such further orders as the Division may deem necessary.
