Pursuant to Division Rule 19.15.15.13, Apache Corporation ("Apache") respectfully requests administrative approval of an unorthodox oil well location for its proposed A State No. 64. This well will be drilled as a development oil well in the Artesia Glorieta-Yeso Pool (96830).

The proposed A State No. 64 will be dedicated to an existing spacing and proration unit in the Artesia Glorieta-Yeso Pool comprising the NW/4 NW/4 of Section 26. This unit is currently dedicated to Apache's: i) existing A State No. 46 (API No. 30-015-38579) located at an unorthodox well location 1080 feet from the North line and 890 feet from the West line; ii) proposed A State No. 61 (API No. 30-015-40838) located at a standard well location 330 feet from the North and West lines; and iii) proposed A State No. 63 (API No. 30-015-41125) located at a standard well location 330 feet from the North line and 990 feet from the West line.

The Artesia Glorieta-Yeso Pool is currently governed by Division Rule 19.19.15.9 which requires standard 40-acre oil spacing and proration units with wells to be located no closer than 330 feet to the outer boundary of the spacing unit.

The proposed unorthodox well location is necessary in order to avoid an existing well and well pad.

The affected offset tracts are the SW/4 NW/4 of Section 26 and the SE/4 NE/4 of Section 27, both in Township 17 South, Range 28 East, NMPM. The SW/4 NW/4 of Section 26 is currently being developed in the Artesia Glorieta-Yeso Pool by numerous

wells operated by Apache. Please note that the working interest ownership between this affected offset tract and the drill tract is common. The SE/4 NE/4 of Section 27 is proposed to be developed in the Artesia Glorieta-Yeso Pool by Occidental Permian Ltd. Notice of this application is being provided to Occidental Permian Ltd. in accordance with Division rules.

Attached is a Form C-102 showing the proposed well, spacing unit and other existing and proposed wells in the spacing unit. Also attached is a map showing the affected offset acreage and a vicinity map.

In summary, approval of the application will provide Apache Corporation the opportunity to recover additional oil and gas reserves from the Artesia Glorieta-Yeso Pool underlying the NW/4 NW/4 of Section 26 that may otherwise not be recovered by the existing or proposed wells, thereby preventing waste, and will not violate correlative rights.





 **Affected Offset Acreage**




