Reference is made to your application received on April 16, 2013.

You have requested to simultaneously dedicate the SE/4 of Section 4, Township 26 North, Range 4 West in Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, in the BS Mesa; Gallup Gas Pool (Pool Code 72920), to the above-described two wells. Applicable spacing rules allow only one well per standard 160-acre unit.

Your application on behalf of Enervest Operating LLC (Enervest) has been duly filed under the provisions of Division Rules 19.1515.11.C NMAC and 19.15.4.12.A(2) NMAC.

It is our understanding Enervest has proposed the simultaneous dedication of this unit to the two wells described for geologic and engineering reasons, in order to prevent waste and maximize production from this unit.

We further understand that ownership of the subject unit and of all offsetting 160-acre units in this pool is identical, so that no notice of this application to offsetting operators or owners is necessary.

Pursuant to the authority granted by Rule 19.15.15.11.C NMAC, the above-described simultaneous dedication is hereby approved.

Jurisdiction of this case is retained for the entry of such further orders as the Division may deem necessary.
