

Describe Cause of Problem and Remedial Action Taken.\*

A 4" water gathering line fractured possibly due to sun fatigue and age. The 4" gathering line has been replaced.

Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.\*

Initially an estimated 100bbbls were released due to a fracture in a 4" gathering line in the pasture. We were able to recover 40bbbls of produced water using a vacuum truck. The gathering line included the Honey Graham #6&7 and Graham Nash #1. Tetra Tech will sample the spill site area to delineate any possible contamination from the release and we will present a work plan to the NMOCD for approval prior to any significant remediation work.




