

Mr. Bratcher:

Pursuant to 29 (19.15.29) NMAC please find enclosed the requisite C-141 Form for the February 24, 2013 release of produced liquids (brine) at our South Carlsbad station. Approximately 10 barrels (420 gallons) of brine impacted the secondary containment of our on-site tank battery when a large amount of produced water was received at the station and caused an over-fill of our permitted Tank T-010. The containment construction consists of an earthen berm and earthen bottom.
