

CAUSE: The 1002 Line was over-pressured due to a processing shut-down downstream; the South Carlsbad Compressor Station shut-down on high-liquid load. A pressure relief valve activated to relieve the pressure build-up.
ACTION: An operational technician attended the relief event and determined the valve has closed properly.

Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.*
All gas was lost to atmosphere.
