Dear Ms. Staley:

The Farmington District Office (FDO) of the Bureau of Land Management (BLM) has received your letter dated April 30, 1996, for downhole commingling of the Blanco Mesaverde and Basin Dakota Pools in the above referenced well.

Prior to the completion of the Mesaverde formation, the only producing horizon completed in this well was the Dakota formation. Subsequent to stimulating the Mesaverde formation, allocation factors will be determined using flow test data and historical data from the Dakota formation. Allocation for both formations will be on a fixed percentage allocation, with 100% of the condensate production attributed to the Mesaverde formation.

Approval to downhole commingle is granted, however we do request that once determined, that the allocation factor be submitted.
