A 3" steel line between the H-pump and the well head corroded due to corrosion.					
Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.*					
Initially 85bbbls of produced water were released from a steel line that had developed a hole going from the H- pump to the well. We were able to recover 35bbbls with a vacuum truck. The release was contained on the location. All free fluids have been recovered. Concho will have the spill site sampled to delineate any possible contamination from the release and we will present a remediation work plan to the NMOCD/BLM for approval prior to any significant remediation work.


