

On the behalf of XTO Energy, R.T. Hicks Consultants requests the withdrawal of the above referenced submittal dated March 25, 2013.

Discussion with you on April 03, 2013 concluded that the Letter of Intent should include how XTO Energy plans to deliver water from Halliburton's CleanWave system to the drill location and back to the CleanWave system.
