Initial soil samples collected in accordance with closure plan approved by OCD Santa Fe (Brad Jones) exceeded TPH reporting limits under pit rule (June 28, 2013) and requires notification to OCD District 1.

Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.* Following meeting with OCD District 1 (Geoffrey Leking) on December 23, 2013, vertical and horizontal extent of TPH in soil will be delineated.
