

OIL RELEASED FROM AN ABOVE GROUND (GATHERING) FAST-LINE CONNECTION. CONNECTION REPLACED AND CONTAMINATED SOIL EXCAVATED AND STOCKPILED. EXCAVATED SOIL WAS SAMPLED AND LABORATORY ANALYZED TO BE APPROVED FOR LAND FARMING, THEN HAULED AWAY TO LAZY ACE LAND FARM UPON APPROVAL.

Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.*

THE AFFECTED SOIL SURFACE AREA WAS APPROXIMATELY 1,000 FT² APPROXIMATELY 80 FEET FROM THE PUMP-JACK. APPROXIMATELY 6-CUBIC YARDS OF SOIL WAS IMMEDIATELY EXCAVATED AT THE SPILL SITE. ANOTHER CUBIC YARD WAS EXCAVATED AFTER THE INITIAL SAMPLING EVENT TO CAPTURE THE REMAINING SOIL SURFACE STAINING AT THE RELEASE. THE SOILS WERE COARSE, MOSTLY SAND TO 24 INCHES UNTIL AN IMPERMEABLE LAYER OF CALICHE ROCK. ALL EXCAVATED SOIL WAS LAND FARMED UPON NMOCD APPROVAL. ALL RECOVERABLE LIQUIDS WERE CONTAINED AND REMOVED WITH THE INITIAL EXCAVATION. REMAINING SOILS HAVE BEEN SAMPLED AND LAB ANALYZED AT CONCENTRATIONS THAT MEET NMOCD REMEDIATED STANDARDS.
