Describe Cause of Problem and Remedial Action Taken.*
A 1" valve on tubing was half open. Cows in the area busted down the guard rail around the wellhead and ran into valve causing it to fully open and release produced water and crude oil. The well was shut off, the valve was closed and roustabouts were called for initial clean-up.

Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.*
The pad area around the wellhead and pumpjack, as well as an area off the west side of the production pad were affected. A crew was called to do initial clean-up of the area, and all excavated soils will be disposed of at an approved NMOCD facility. Vertical and horizontal delineation samples will be taken and sent to a NMOCD approved facility. **Depth to Ground Water: >100' (approximately 100-150', Section 11, T22S-R31E, per Trend Map), Wellhead Protection Area: No, Distance to Surface Water Body: >1000', SITE RANKING IS 0.** Yates Petroleum requests closure based on work being completed as approved by both NMOCD and BLM from a work plan submitted to both agencies on February 24, 2014. All analytical reports and site diagram of release area were submitted to both agencies in the work plan. Off the production pad Yates went ahead and excavated to a depth of 4', even though it was required by the work plan. No further work is needed at this site.
