A rubber coupling wore out on the pump and the check valve failed. Causing all produced fluid to back up into the water tanks and over flow. The rubber coupling and the check valves have been replaced.

Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.\*

Initially 23bbbls of produced water were released. We were able to recover 23bbbls of produced water with a vacuum truck. The spill was contained inside the lined facility. All free fluid has been recovered. Any contaminated gravel has been removed, the liner has been steam cleaned and we has replaced with fresh gravel as necessary. This location has been returned to its prior condition.
