On Friday October 11, 2013 @ 0525 hrs a release occurred at the Philmex #9 SWD Located ~10 miles north east of the Maljamar Production Office. Contract Vacuum truck driver notified COPC Employee that the SWD tank at the Philmex #9 SWD had ran over. Employee immediately notified Supervisor and HSE Lead. Spill amount was ~13.68 BBLs of Produced Water with 10 BBLs of produced water recovered. Spill area was 30 ft wide X 10 ft Long X 12 inches deep and was contained inside the diked area. Spill will be remediated in place according to COPC and NMOCD requirements.

Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.\*

Spill was contained inside Dike
