Reference is made to your recent application for a correction to Division Order No. DHC-1305-2nd Amendment dated December 4, 1998. It appears that Order No. DHC-1305-2nd Amendment does not reflect the correct percentages for allocation between the Basin-Dakota and Blanco-Mesaverde Gas Pools.

The request for correction should be approved.

Assignment of allowable to the well and allocation of production from the well shall be on the following basis:

Blanco-Mesaverde Gas Pool	Oil 52%	Gas 72%
Basin-Dakota Gas Pool	Oil 48%	Gas 28%
