


Describe Cause of Problem and Remedial Action Taken.* <b>On 5/16/2014, an engine skid drain tank overflowed and approximately 5bbl of used oil and condensate spilled into lined secondary containment. Upon inspection, the integrity of the top of the tank was found to be compromised, and a replacement tank was ordered on 5/18/2014. The old tank was removed on 6/16/2014 to begin removal/replacement of contaminated secondary containment gravel. Upon removal of the secondary containment gravel, a tear in the secondary containment liner was discovered. The liner was removed and excavation began to determine the extent of historic contamination beyond secondary containment.</b>		
Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.* <b>To date, approximately 126 yd<sup>3</sup> have been excavated from the area surrounding and underneath the original bermed containment. Excavation will continue until TPH, BTEX, and Benzene are below the levels outlined in "NMOCD Guidelines for Remediation of Leaks, Spills, and Releases". The area will be backfilled with clean soil, re-lined, re-bermed, and a new tank will be placed.</b>
