The collar around an 8" fiberglass water line separated causing an estimated 1560 bbls of produced water to be released.

Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.\*  
The lease operator discovered the leak causing an estimated 1560 bbls of produced water to be released outside of location and onto pasture, the north side of the north west corner. Approximately 30 bbls of produced water was recovered. The well was shut in and all lines coming to the SWD were shut off. All necessary parties were notified. The water line was repaired.
