Dear Mr. Jones:

On behalf of Enterprise Products Operating Company Inc. (Enterprise), Kleinfelder, Inc. (Kleinfelder) is submitting this proof of public notice in support of the hydrostatic discharge permit for the B-6 Lateral pipeline.

The Notice of Intent (NOI) to discharge hydrostatic test water from the B-6 Lateral and application to discharge was deemed administratively complete by the New Mexico Energy, Minerals, and Natural Resources Department Oil Conservation Division (NMOCD) on November 7, 2013.

Enterprise is planning to conduct hydrostatic testing on a new 12-inch inner-diameter line named B-6 Replacement Lateral in Eddy County, New Mexico. Actual placement of water into the pipeline is scheduled to start on or about May 15, 2014. Approximately 58,397 feet of piping will be tested.

The landowners were notified by certified mail in November 18, 2013.







PUBLIC NOTICE

The United States Department of Transportation (USDOT) requires periodic preventative tests on all USDOT regulated pneumatic tireless products. The purpose of this notice is to inform the public that the following tireless products have been identified as being subject to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division (NMOCD) in accordance with Subsections B, C, E, and F of 20 2 2.3106 New Mexico Administrative Code. The local Enterprise making address is Enterprise Products Operating LLC, 1001 Andrews Highway, Suite 200, Midland, TX 79701.

The purpose of hydraulic testing with water is to confirm the pipeline's ability to maintain maximum allowable operating pressure. The pipeline will be filled with water, and then pressurized to a level higher than the standard operating pressure for a specified duration.

Enterprise has submitted an application for hydraulic test water discharge that will occur on private land at latitude 32° 56' 02" N, longitude 104° 46' 17" W in County, New Mexico. The location of the discharge is approximately 13 miles northwest of Carlsbad, New Mexico. To reach the discharge location from the intersection of NM 524 and US 283 in Carlsbad head west on NM 524 NW 1/4 SW 36 for approximately 2.4 miles, turn a slight right onto NM 524 NW 1/4 SW 36 for 0.1 miles, turn northwest onto US 283 NW 1/4 SW 36 for 0.1 miles, turn west onto White Pine Road and continue for 1.9 miles, turn south onto County Road 284-SW 36th Street and continue for 1.7 miles, turn north onto the pipeline right-of-way just east of 0.4 miles. The discharge will be on the right side of the road. The hydraulic test is scheduled for December 20, 2013 with discharge of the test water scheduled on or about December 30, 2013.

Approximately eleven miles of new, multi-gas piping will be tested by 300,000 gallons of potable, municipal water from the City of Carlsbad and the amount of water used will be discharged. Enterprise will collect, store and discharge. Enterprise will collect, store and discharge a sample of the water obtained from the test section of the pipeline. The sample will be analyzed for water quality. Upon NMOCD concurrence that the discharge water meets the water quality standards of NMAC 20 2 2.3106, Enterprise will discharge the water in accordance with the approved discharge permit. If discharge to the ground surface is approved, the water will be released into a pipeline with a flow, discharged to a disposal and discharge system, and allowed to flow onto private surface as private property, not approved by the landowner. If water discharge to the water surface is approved, the water will be transported from the project site to DOT-approved tanker trucks by an NMOCD-approved hauler to an NMOCD-approved water disposal facility.

The nearest water supply well with a reported water depth is located approximately 0.5 miles to the east. The depth is water reported to be less than 40 feet below the ground surface. The ground elevation at the well location is approximately 3,147 feet above mean sea level (MSL). The elevation of the ground surface at the discharge area is approximately 3,120 feet. The notice of intent and discharge plan outlines how produced water and waste will be properly managed, including handling, storage, and final disposition. 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

for the B-6 Lateral Hydrostatic Test.



The proposed discharge/collection/retention location on private property near the northwestern end of the B-6 Lateral located in the SW/4 of the NW/4, Section 23, Township 20 South, Range 25 East, NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico. OCD acknowledges the receipt of the filing fee (\$100.00) and the permit fee (\$600.00) for the permit from a submittal dated November 4, 2013.

Based on the information provided in the request, the hydrostatic test water discharge is hereby approved with the following understandings and conditions:

1. Enterprise will be testing approximately 11.06 miles (58,397) feet of a new 12.25-inch inner diameter natural gas transmission pipeline, approximately 15 miles northwest of Carlsbad, New Mexico;
2. Enterprise will acquire the hydrostatic test water from the City of Carlsbad, New Mexico;
3. Enterprise will generate approximately 360,000 gallons of hydrostatic test wastewater from the test event. The hydrostatic wastewater will remain in the pipeline while being sampled and awaiting test results from a certified laboratory;
4. Enterprise shall analyze all samples of wastewater generated from the hydrostatic test to demonstrate the results do not exceed the standards as set forth in Subsections A, B, and C of

the 20.6.2.3103 NMAC, except for Combined Radium 226 & Radium 228 due to pre-test results;

5. Enterprise shall submit the test results via email or fax to the OCD for review and subsequent approval or disapproval for the test wastewater to be discharged;
6.
