The project areas for these wells include the E/2 and E/2 W/2 of Section 12, and E/2 of Section 11, Township 23 North, 6 West, NMPM, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico.

Commingled gas production from the wells shall be measured and sold at Lybrook O01-2306 Well No.1H tank battery in (Unit O) of Section 1, Township 23 North, Range 6 West, NMPM, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico.

The gas production from each well shall be separately metered, before commingling with production from other wells. The meters shall be calibrated quarterly in accordance with Rule 19.15.12.10.C(2) NMAC.

This installation shall be installed and operated in accordance with the applicable Division Rules and Regulations.

The producer/Operator shall notify the transporter of this commingling authority and the Aztec District Office of the Division prior to implementation of commingling operations.

This approval is subject to like approval by the U.S. Bureau of Land Management.
