Transport truck was getting ready to load out slop tanks and found a malfunctioned/ failed "hose" that spilled a condensate/ produced water mix of approx. 20 BBl's into the truck load out containment. The driver replaced the hose and sucked up as much of the mostly water mix that he could (all but about 5 gallons).

Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.\*

The affected area was the Black River CS truck load out earthen berm. The driver sucked out the free standing liquid from the spill.
