Describe Cause of Problem and Remedial Action Taken.\* A hammer union became loose due to vibration and movement on the line. The union was re-tightened and the line was secured.

Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.\*  
The spill impacted approximately 1400 sq.ft. of pasture, all of the free product was recovered with a vacuum truck. On 2/13/15, crews started removing the saturated soil and placing it on plastic, Basin Environmental will oversee the soil removal and conduct the final remediation. BOPCO will submit a Final C-141 and closure report upon completion.


**DESCRIPTION (What happened?):**
