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**Re: Application of EOG Resources, Inc. for administrative approval of an unorthodox well location for its Frazier 34 State Com #504H Well to be completed in Section 27, Township 24 South, Range 33 East, N.M.P.M., Lea County, New Mexico.**

Dear Mr. Catanach:

EOG Resources, Inc. (OGRID No. 7377) seeks administrative approval of an unorthodox well location for its **Frazier 34 State Com #504H Well** to be completed within the Triste Draw; Bone Spring, East Pool (96682) underlying Section 27, Township 24 South, Range 33 East, N.M.P.M., Lea County, New Mexico. This well will be drilled from a surface location 250 feet from the North line and 2140 feet from the East line (Unit B) of Section 34. The upper most perforation will be 330 feet from the South line and 2315 feet from the East line of Section 27 (Unit O) and the lower most perforation will be 330 feet from the North line and 2315 feet from the East line of Section 27 (Unit B). Since this acreage is governed by the Division's statewide rules which provides for wells to be located no closer than 330 feet to the outer boundary of the spacing unit, the completed interval for this well will be unorthodox. Approval of the unorthodox completed interval will allow for efficient well spacing in Section 27, prevent waste of a productive reservoir and improve well performance.

**Exhibit A** is the Well Location and Acreage Dedication Plat (Form C-102), which shows that the completed interval of the proposed **Frazier 34 State #504H Well** encroaches on the spacing and proration unit to the Northwest, West and Southwest.

**Exhibit B** is a land plat for Section 27 and the surrounding sections that shows the proposed **Frazier 34 State Com #504H Well** in relation to adjoining units and existing wells.



EOG is the sole operator of the spacing units affected by the encroachment to the West and Southwest. Murchison Oil & Gas, Inc. is the only party affected by the encroachment to the Northwest. Murchison Oil & Gas has been provided a copy of this application and all attachments by certified mail, and has been advised that if they have an objection it must be filed in writing with the division within 20 days from the date the division receives this application. A courtesy copy of this application has been provided to the New Mexico State Land Office.




