The project area for these wells include the E/2 E/2 of Section 19, W/2 W/2 of Section 29, and NW/4 NW/4 of Section 32, Township 26 South, Range 33 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico.

The commingled oil and gas production shall be measured and sold at the Porter Brown Well No. 1H Central Tank Battery (CTB) located in Unit P, Section 19, Township 26 South, Range 33 East, Lea County, New Mexico.

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Oil and gas production from each of the leases shall be separately metered before commingling with production from other wells. The allocation meters shall be calibrated quarterly in accordance with Rule 19.15.12.10.C (2) NMAC

The operator shall notify the transporter of this commingling authority.

The operator shall notify the Hobbs district office of the Division upon commencement of commingling operations.

This approval is subject to like approval from the Bureau of Land Management (BLM) before commencement of the commingling operations.
