


Dear Mr. Fesmire:

Attached is an application to down hole commingle (Exception to Rule 303A) the reference intervals in this well bore: This well is presently completed in the Loco Hills Paddock. We plan to set a retrievable bridge plug above the Paddock perforations and **temporarily complete** this well bore in the San Andres zone to establish the proper production allocation by testing. Once the allocation is set we will remove the bridge plug and begin down hole commingled operation. We anticipate this testing may take a few months.

A copy of this application and the original 3160-5 is being sent to the Bureau of Land Management and interest owners for this temporary re-completion in anticipation of your approval of the DHC.





This well is presently completed as a Cedar Lake Yeso well. We now propose to begin the down hole commingling process for the San Andres zone and Cedar Lake Yeso. After receipt of NMOCD approval we will set a RBP above the Cedar Lake Yeso and perforate the San Andres zone and test to establish a proper production allocation. After the testing period, we will recover the bridge plug and begin Down hole commingled production operation for the two zones into the existing Gissler A2 tank battery in Unit J, Sec. 14, T17S, R30E. We expect this process to take a few months. A copy of the NMOCD commingling application is attached for your record.
