EOG Resources, Inc. (OGRID No. 7377) seeks administrative approval of an unorthodox well location for its **Nautilus 16 State Com #701H Well** to be completed within the WC-025 G-09 A263416B; Upper Wolfcamp Pool (98105) underlying the E/2 E/2 of Section 16, Township 26 South, Range 34 East, N.M.P.M., Lea County, New Mexico. As reflected on the Well Location and Acreage Dedication Plat (Form C-102) enclosed as **Exhibit A**, this well will be drilled from a surface location 230 feet from the North line and 1685 feet from the East line (Unit B) of Section 16. The upper most perforation will be 330 feet from the North line and 1260 feet from the East line (Unit A) and the lower most perforation will be 330 feet from the South line and 1260 feet from the East line (Unit P) of Section 16. Since this pool is governed by the Division's statewide rules for oil wells, the completed interval for this well encroaches on the 40-acre spacing units to the Northwest, West and Southwest. Approval of this unorthodox completed interval will allow for efficient well spacing in Section 16, thereby preventing waste.

Enclosed as **Exhibit B** is a land plat of Section 16 and the surrounding sections that shows the proposed well in relation to adjoining units and existing wells. EOG is the sole operator and mineral lessee of the state lands affected by the encroachment to the West. The parties affected by the encroachment to the Northwest and Southwest are listed on **Exhibit C**. Each of these affected parties has been provided a copy of this application by certified mail and advised that any objection must be filed in writing with the division within 20 days from the date the division receives this application. A courtesy copy of this application has also been provided to the New Mexico State Land Office.


