The project area for these wells include the N/2 of Section 1, Township 17 South, Range 29 East, NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico.

The commingled oil and gas production from the wells detailed above shall be measured and sold at the Parliament 1 Federal Com. UBB Well No. 4H Central Tank Battery (CTB), located in Unit H, Section 1, Township 17 South, Range 29 East, NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico.

The oil and gas production shall be continuously measured with allocation meters for the Parliament 1 Federal Com. UBB Well No. 4H, Munds 1 Federal Com. LBB Well No. 21H, and the Munds 1 Federal Com. Well No. 12H wells, before commingling with other wells. Production for the Parliament 1 Federal Com. LBB Well No. 13H shall be based on the subtraction method of the total production from the CTB minus the metered production of the other metered wells. The allocation meters shall be calibrated quarterly in accordance with Rule 19.15.12.10.C (2) NMAC.

This installation shall be installed and operated in accordance with the applicable Division Rules. It is the responsibility of the producer to notify the transporter of this commingling authority.

**This approval is subject to like approval from the Bureau of Land Management before commencing commingling operations.**

The operator shall notify the Artesia District office of the Division prior to implementation of the commingling operations.
