Leak was discovered this morning at 3 am. GPS is displayed on photos. Mostly produced water with some oil. The rupture due to corrosion in our steel line was clamped. The well was shut in until section can be replaced. No fluids were recovered. A C-141 will be submitted. Leak may exceed 25 bbls though not by much. The leak affected 1170 square feet of pasture west of the road and 915 square feet of lease road. Thanks!
