The landing gear of a tanker truck settled into the soil due to its weight. The tanker truck was full of water, which was used to produce drilling mud as part of the ongoing construction activities at the pipeline. After the tanker truck was empty, the construction crew leveled the truck and discovered that a pipe at the bottom of the truck ruptured and released approximately 8 bbls of a mixture of stagnate water and old drilling mud.		
Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.*		
Enterprise will be excavating the contaminated soil and performing soil sampling in accordance with NMOCD remediation guidelines and Enterprise's General Release Notification, Response, and remediation Plan (dated March 9, 2015). A final C-141 form will be submitted with analytical data to demonstrate cleanup is complete.
